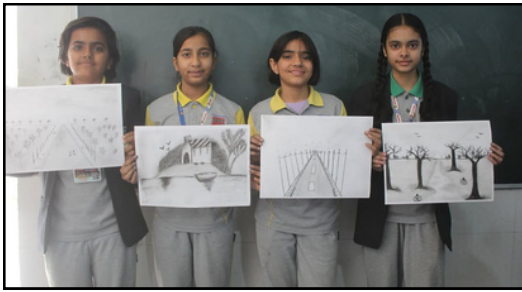


SPIC MACAY Presents Gotipua Dance Performance

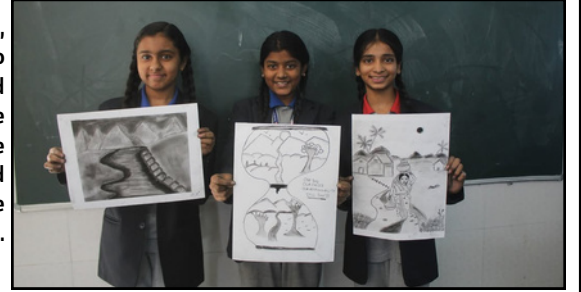

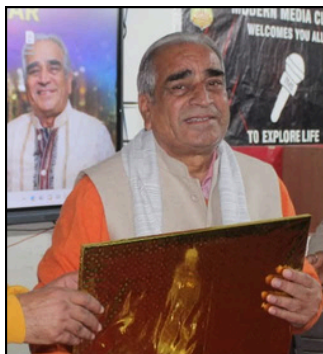

The Making of Toppers : Four Stories of Success

My academic journey began at The Modern School, where I studied from PG to Class 10. Those early years were not just about textbooks and exams, they were about building curiosity, confidence, and a strong academic foundation. The school nurtured my love for learning and encouraged me to aim high. In Class 10, I secured 93.8% and achieved School Rank 1. That achievement wasn't just a number-it was a turning point. It strengthened my belief that consistency and clarity could take me further than I had imagined. With a clear goal in mind, I moved to Kota to prepare for JEE. Many people describe JEE preparation as stressful and overwhelming. But for me, it never felt like a burden. I genuinely enjoyed studying Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. Each concept felt like a puzzle waiting to be solved. Instead of memorizing formulas, I focused on understanding the "why" behind them. Slowly, formulas stopped feeling like facts to cram-they became ideas that naturally stayed in my mind. When concepts are clear, problem-solving becomes instinctive. That shift in mindset transformed preparation into passion. My consistency and disciplined routine reflected in my results. I scored 99.62 percentile in JEE Main Session 1 and became the district topper. That moment was not just about achievement-it was about validation. Validation that hard work done with interest and clarity always pays off. Today, as I appear for my Class 12 board examinations, I honestly feel that JEE preparation-when done with understanding-can be more manageable than board exams. The key lies in discipline, not drama, in clarity, not cramming. Now, my focus is set on the next milestone-Joint Entrance Examination - Advanced. The journey continues, and so does the learning. To every student dreaming big: Do not be afraid of competitive exams. Do not label preparation as a struggle even before you begin. Fall in love with concepts. Be consistent. Be disciplined. When your effort becomes your habit, success becomes your result.



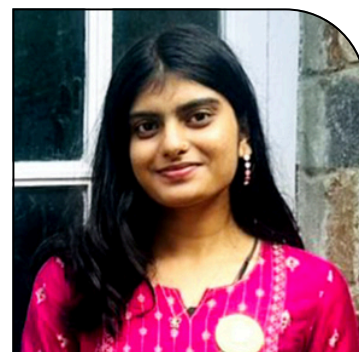

I began my JEE preparation in Class 11 with a dream that felt ambitious yet exciting. Very soon, I realized that JEE is not just about solving tough Physics numericals or mastering tricky concept soon became a true test of patience and perseverance. There were days when mock test scores were disappointing, when concepts felt impossible, and when self-doubt tried to overpower confidence. But I learned an important lesson: pressure doesn't break you; it builds you-if you choose to grow. Managing school studies along with competitive preparation was one of my biggest challenges. My time at The Modern School shaped my discipline, strengthened my fundamentals, and kept me grounded. The structured academic environment and supportive teachers helped me stay consistent while preparing for a much larger goal. Alongside my regular studies, consistent self-study and practice became the backbone of my preparation. Revising concepts regularly, solving a wide variety of questions, and carefully analyzing my mistakes helped me improve step by step. Whenever I faced setbacks, I treated them as opportunities to learn rather than reasons to give up. "Success in JEE is not about being perfect; it's about improving every single day." Scoring 99.38 percentile was not just an achievement-it was proof that dedication, smart strategy, and unwavering belief can turn dreams into reality. And this journey taught me one final truth: dreams don't work unless you do.

Will I Be Able to Do It Again? Yes, I Did - Proving Myself Twice." Scoring 97.2% and securing the District Top position in Class 10 was a proud moment for me, but it also brought a question to my mind - would I be able to do it again in Class 12? As a Science (Biology) student, many of my classmates were preparing for JEE and NEET, while my focus was mainly on CUET and board preparation. At times, this made me wonder if I would be able to match their level of preparation. However, instead of comparing myself with others, I chose to focus on improving myself every day. I strongly believe that whatever I choose to do, I must give it my 100 percent, focusing on the quality of learning rather than the number of study hours. Physics was the most challenging subject for me, so I practiced it the most and solved questions regularly. I focused on conceptual clarity instead of rote learning. I often explained topics from Physics, Chemistry, and Biology to my parents because I believe that when we explain something to others, we understand and remember it better. Every family faces ups and downs, and mine was no exception. But we can either turn such moments into excuses or into motivation to work harder - I chose the second path. My parents, especially my mother, always supported me and never pressured me to study, which helped me stay focused and confident. I was also fortunate to share a strong and inspiring bond with my teachers. As a proud student of TMS, I am deeply grateful to my school for providing a nurturing academic environment and constant encouragement. The guidance of my teachers and the supportive atmosphere of the school played a significant role in shaping my learning journey and strengthening my confidence. With dedication and consistency, I scored 98.2% and secured the District Top position once again in Class 12. When you truly want to see the proud smiles on your family's faces, motivation comes naturally. For me, this achievement is just the beginning, not the end, and it inspires me to continue working hard towards my bigger dreams.
